# **Directions for Use Directions for Use**

#### **Prevention of Stains**

- 1. Backwash the filter, then allow the pump to run continuously.
- 2. Apply 1 quart of Pool Magnet<sup>®</sup> Plus per 10,000 gallons for every 1.0 ppm metals. Maximum recommended dose is 3 qts. per 10,000 gallons. If staining is present, add product directly over these stains.
- 3. If the total amount of metals present exceeds 1.0 ppm, apply Sparkle Up<sup>®</sup> Filter Aid 48 hours after Pool Magnet<sup>®</sup> Plus addition to assist in metal removal.

Temporary clouding may occur upon addition.

#### Removal of Fresh Stains

- 1. Turn the pump off for 8 hours.
- 2. Slowly and as close to the surface of the water as possible, pour one to three (depending on severity of stains) quarts of Pool Magnet<sup>®</sup> Plus directly in the area of the stain.
- 3. Do not swim or operate pump for 24 hours.
- 4. After the waiting period, turn the pump back on to circulate the water and brush the pool daily for 5-7 days.
- 5. Use BioGuard<sup>®</sup> Sparkle Up<sup>®</sup> in the filter to aid in the removal of redissolved metals.
- For Iron staining, use Erase<sup>®</sup> Iron Stain Remover in conjunction with Pool Magnet<sup>®</sup> Plus. Follow Erase<sup>®</sup> Iron Stain Remover label instructions.
- For white plaster pools (only) where large metal stains have aged into the pools surface, draining and acid washing is recommended.

#### Maintenance Dose

• When fill water contains metals, add 3 oz. of Pool Magnet<sup>®</sup> Plus per 1,000 gallons of water added to the pool.
